

The City of Prinsburg held its regular monthly council meeting on February 10, 2026, at 1:00 pm, with Mayor Mitch Swart presiding. Council members present were Greg Bonnema, Mike Bredeck, Dan Negen, and Nate Marcus. Also in attendance were City Employees Nolan Slagter and Sarah Van Dyken.

ART 1. Mike Bredeck moves to approve the Regular meeting minutes of January 6, 2026. Nate Marcus supports this motion. MSP

ART 2. Nate Marcus moves to approve the Claims presented in the amount of \$9,469.33. Mitch Swart supports this motion. MSP
